2. **WRITE A SCRIPT:** You will work together in your group to write a 7 - 10 minute script. Please see the Script Rubric for more details.

3. **PRACTICE, PRACTICE, PRACTICE.**

4. **RECORD:** You will either record your skit as a mini television segment using camcorders, or as a podcast.

5. **PRESENTATION:** You will present your finished product to the class. Please see the Presentation Rubric for more details.
